



Church Council Highlights

Meeting of July 1st

Vice-Chairman: Vice-Chairman Zane Shullanberger requested an update from the Organ Committee. The Organ Dedication service was scheduled for Sunday, July 22, at 3:30 PM. [All costs associated with the organ, including installation and the honorarium for Rev. Meissler playing for the dedication service, were covered through special donations. No budgeted monies were used.] The work of the Committee will conclude after this event. An update was given on the Cookbook. Members are encouraged to turn in their recipes.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret McCloskey reviewed the written report. As of June 30, 2018, income over expenses was + 3,098.61. (A brief financial statement is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

Financial Secretary: La Nell Felps reviewed the written report in place of Judi Jopling. The quarterly weekly offering average for the months of April, May, and June was \$2,530.13.

Elders: Our electoral circuit will be meeting soon to vote for delegates for the 2019 Synod Convention. Margaret McCloskey has volunteered to serve, along with Pastor Wehmeyer, as our voting representative at the circuit meeting.

Trustees: An issue with one of the AC units in the Sanctuary was discussed. (It has since been repaired.)

Evangelism: Doug Weir reported that the Committee had met in June. Coffee cups have been purchased with the church name and contact information on them. Local restaurants have graciously volunteered to serve coffee in these cups. A brochure rack has been hung in the Narthex. The committee next planned to meet on Sunday, July 29, following the Divine Service.

Fellowship: Marla Cappella reported that 180 breakfast tacos were served at Mission Devine by the Board. Plans were underway for the potluck on Sunday, July 15, and the Reception following the Organ Dedication on Sunday, July 22. The Board will be helping with snacks for VBS.
