Highlights

Meeting of July 2nd

Chairman: Jim Danner requested an update on the organ purchase from Mt. Calvary LCMS in San Antonio. [As of July 24, \$12,510 had been pledged/received. Donations over the \$10,000 cost of the organ are being applied to installation costs.] Estimates are being solicited for installation, which will involve building organ speaker chambers. An update was provided on the Picture Directory. It should be published by the Fall.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret McCloskey reviewed the written report. Year to date income over expenses at the end of June was -\$1,080.33. This number reflects income set aside for the church organ expenditure that has not yet occurred. (A brief financial statement is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

Financial Secretary: Claudia Carberry reported for Judi Jopling that, with income included for the church organ, the weekly average of donations for June was \$4,878.

Elders: It was reported that Dominique Trevino and Malcolm & Rhonda Brown are considered self-excluded, in accordance with our DSLC Bylaw 3.4.

Trustees: Doug Carberry reported that several issues have involved repairs on the HVAC units in the Fellowship Hall and Sanctuary. Thanks were expressed to Doug Weir, Robert & Marla Cappella, Glen Felps, and Doug Haass for their help in assisting with painting, sanding, and other remodeling work. The sidewalks and Fellowship Hall parking lot have been power-washed. Judi Jopling and Wendy Jones will serve as our new custodians.

Evangelism: Doug Weir reported that gifts were given at the New Member Meal to all who joined our fellowship over the past year. The Kaiser family, with Lutheran Bible Translators, will be visiting us on Sunday, October 15.

Stewardship: Robert Cappella reported that several members assisted with sanding, painting, and door work in the Fellowship Hall.

Human Care: Sharon Stromske reported that a member had been given financial assistance in June, and the Devine Food Pantry donations are ongoing monthly.

Fellowship: Marla Cappella reviewed the written report. Over 125 people were served by the Board at Mission Devine on June 15. The Board will be hosting several meals with upcoming special events in the months ahead.

Christian Education: Claudia Carberry noted that, with Summer, Sunday School attendance is down. Rally Day is scheduled for Sunday, August 27.

Gift of Hope: Robert Cappella reviewed the written report. He expressed a desire to find a new Chairman for this event.

Pastor: Pastor Wehmeyer reviewed his written report which included Family Care, Official Acts, and the latest Church Statistics.
