Highlights

Meeting of June 3rd

Chairman: Chairman Jim Danner requested an update from the Organ Committee. The beam across the back of the Sanctuary had been installed. Coverings for the subwoofer, and placement of the organ speakers, was scheduled to be completed within a week of this meeting. An update was given on the Cookbook. The desire is to make this a personal cookbook with stories and memories included with the recipes. The DSLC Phone Tree is being finalized.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret McCloskey reviewed the written report. As of May 31, 2018, income over expenses was + 10,162.24. (A brief financial statement is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

Financial Secretary: Judi Jopling reviewed the written report. The weekly average of offerings for May was \$4,273.51. An additional gift was received for Gift of Hope.

Trustees: Doug Weir reported that a relay on one of the HVAC units in the Sanctuary has been replaced. The sprinkler system control unit has been fine-tuned. Bids are being gathered for the parking lot repair.

Evangelism: Doug Weir reported that the Committee planned to meet for the first time on Sunday, June 10.
