June is a favorite month of many as we drift into the “Summer months” with our schedules a little lighter, if, for no other reason, than school is not in session. Of course, there are also a couple of holidays on the secular calendar. June 14th is set aside as Flag Day. On June 18th, Father’s Day, we rejoice in God’s gift of Fathers.

While the secular calendar has these special days set aside for various celebrations, the Church Calendar has a very special, holy day set aside on June 4th: Pentecost. Often referred to as the “Birthday of the Church,” Pentecost marks the coming of the Holy Spirit. Based on Acts 2, this Holy Day occurs 50 days after The Resurrection of Our Lord and 10 days after The Ascension of Our Lord. This feast is the culmination of Easter.

Without the gift of the Holy Spirit, we would be dead in our sins and lost forever. Surely we remember the explanation to the Third Article of the Apostles’ Creed: “I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith...”

We will celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit in the Divine Service on this day, and we will also celebrate Holy Communion. Remembering the fire that rested on the disciples’ heads, you are invited to wear something **red**.
