Highlights

Meeting of May 6th

Chairman: Chairman Jim Danner requested an update from the Organ Committee. A bid has been received to place a beam at the back of the Sanctuary to install the organ speakers. This was expected to be completed within 30 days. This beam will match the architecture of the other beams in the Sanctuary. Another business item, the consideration of an AED (Automatic External Defibrillator), continues to be discussed, including the pursuing of grants. A rough-draft of the Phone Tree was presented. Council members were asked to provide their input.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret McCloskey reviewed the written report. As of April 30, 2018, income over expenses was - 2,408.40. (A brief financial statement is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

Financial Secretary: Glenda Allen reviewed the written report. The weekly average of offerings for April was \$1,787.28. In addition, one memorial was received for Gift of Hope.

Elders: Johnny Schuknecht reminded the Council of weekly communion, approved by the congregation, that began in May.

Trustees: Doug Weir reported that a new electric provider has been secured for the Sanctuary, as the former contract expired May 1, 2018. The new, three-year contract will be cheaper than the former one.

Evangelism: Doug Weir reported that the Committee hopes to have a meeting soon. The Board provided t-shirts for all volunteers at the Gift of Hope.

Stewardship: Robert Cappella noted that more offering envelopes had arrived. If any member would like a set, please contact Robert.

Human Care: No report.

Fellowship: Marla Cappella reported that the donuts, provided before and after Sunday School & Bible Class, cost about \$64 per month. The Board will be providing breakfast on Wednesday, June 13, for Mission Devine.

Christian Education: Glenda Allen reminded the Council that VBS is scheduled for Saturday, August 18. Glenda Allen and Sharon Stromske will be working to clean-up and straighten the Sunday School rooms soon.
