Meeting of February 2

Chairman: Jim Danner received updates on several items. The Phone Tree is being updated with the new directory information. A new lapel microphone will be purchased for use on Sundays when needed. Confirmed dates for Guest Proclaimers for the Anniversary Services: March 15—Rev. David Londenberg; July 12—Rev. Odis Doyal; October 4—Rev. Mike Newman. A picture/video presentation is in the works.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret McCloskey reviewed the written report. Income over expenses as of January 31, 2020 was -\$5,901.11. (An abbreviated financial report is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

Financial Secretary: Judi Jopling reviewed the written report. The weekly average for offerings during the month of January was \$1,602.88. (Our weekly needs are: \$2,700.00).

Elders: Johnny Schuknecht reported that the iPad (Facebook Live) sound quality has improved with the additional microphone (not the lapel microphone mentioned earlier) that was purchased in January specifically for the iPad. Fine-tuning is still ongoing.

Trustees: Bill Jopling reported that the gutters for the Fellowship Hall were scheduled to be installed on February 4. The new lights in the Fellowship Hall have been a big improvement.

Evangelism: Doug Weir reported that the congregation is now a member of the Devine Chamber of Commerce and the Hondo Chamber of Commerce. New additions have been made to the Church Library.
