### Highlights

#### Meeting of April 2nd

**Chairman:** Jim Danner requested an update on Old Business Items. Ethel Martin has volunteered to lead the Pictorial Directory Committee. Any who are interested in serving on this committee should contact Ethel.

**Treasurer's Report:** Claudia Carberry reviewed the written report. Income over expenses at the end of March was -\$437.14. (A brief financial statement is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

**Financial Secretary:** Judi Jopling reviewed the written report. The weekly average of offerings for March was \$3,936.12, which included Wednesday Lent offerings.

**Elders:** Johnny Schuknecht reported that final arrangements are being made for the new sound equipment. Easter yard crosses left over from previous years are available for any who would like one.

**Trustees:** Doug Carberry reported on the remodeling, which included the upcoming completion of tile work. The outside of the Fellowship Hall windows will be re-calked and weatherized. The mop sink in the janitor's closet was scheduled to be repaired. Yard maintenance continues to be addressed. Doug Weir was thanked for the painting he had done in the Fellowship Hall.
