



Church Council Highlights

Meeting of August 6th

Chairman: Jim Danner noted the need to establish a Nominating Committee for the election of officers at the end of the year. The Committee is made up of: Judi Jopling, Zane Shullanberger, and Doug Weir. Positions open for nominations are: Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Human Care Chair, and one Elder. Share your thoughts with any member of the Committee.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret McCloskey reviewed the written report. Year to date income over expenses at the end of July was -\$591.31. This number reflects income of over \$12,000 set aside for the church organ expenditure that has not yet occurred. Over \$10,000 of non-budgeted monies were spent on the remodeling. (A brief financial statement is found elsewhere in this newsletter. Members may view a detailed financial report by contacting the Treasurer or the Church Office.)

Financial Secretary: Judi Jopling reviewed the written report. The weekly average of offerings for July was \$1,714.18.

Elders: The Board and Pastor continue to address members who have neglected the Means of Grace.

Trustees: Doug Weir noted that the A/C repairs seem to have been completed.

Evangelism: Reformation and Friendship Sunday will be October 29.
